

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE

I, Deputy/ Agent Patrick Green, am a full salaried, certified, commissioned Deputy employed with the County of Hidalgo Sheriff's Department and assigned to the Border Drug Task Force, in the County of Hidalgo and State of New Mexico, do state the following:

On January 2nd 2013 at approximately 1307 hours, I was contacted by the Deming Central Dispatch and requested to meet with Deming Police Officers on a traffic stop at the Wal-Mart in Deming in reference to a K9 Deployment. I arrived at the location at approximately 1315 hours and met with Deming Police Officers and Lieutenant Matthew Rudiger.

Once Officers concluded their business with the person driving the brown in color Dodge pickup truck, they asked that I deploy my K9 partner "LEO" for a free air sniff. They also told me that the driver (Identified as David Eckert) had given consent to search the vehicle.

I deployed my K9 partner "LEO" on the brown in color Dodge vehicle that Officers had stopped. I began the deployment at the front of the vehicle and in a counter clockwise direction. Upon second pass, LEO indicated to the presence of an unknown narcotic odor at the opened driver's door window and alerted there. I then had LEO enter the vehicle and LEO indicated and alerted to the presence of an unknown narcotic odor on the drivers seat of the vehicle.

I notified Deming Police Officers of the result of the deployment and left the scene at approximately 1329 hours. Nothing further to report.
